  - B. Tricia and Paul Pietig spoke for Gigi's Playhouse, an organization that works with Down's Syndrome kids. We gave them a check for \$2333.
  - C. Krable Mentzer spoke on behalf of Easter Seals and Camp Sunnyside. Easter Seals works with disabled individuals of all ages toward living independent lives. We also gave her a check for \$2333.
- 4. Chaplain's report:
  - Fr. Neal discussed the new speed-bumps on the parking lot. He would also like to put up security cameras covering the grounds and the parking lot.
- 5. Financial Secretary (Steve Michaud)
