Please join us to clean up the outside areas of school, church, parish office, and Father Raphael's house with our students and teachers.


#### Important things to know:

#### **Enrollment for 2024-2025 School Year**

You are an important part of our school community. We want to save your spot for next year! Enrollment for 2024-25 is open now, and current families must enroll by November 15 to receive priority. After November 15, enrollment will be open to other families in our parish followed by new families in the broader community.

### **Next Steps:**

- Scan the QR code to complete the enrollment form.
- After this form has been submitted, watch for an email within 2-3 weeks from Blackbaud Tuition Management to set up your account.
- Pay the \$100 per student enrollment fee when setting up your tuition account. (This replaces the registration fee typically due after the first of the year.)
- You will receive a confirmation email from Blackbaud when these steps are completed.



We recognize the revised enrollment process is taking place earlier than what you are accustomed to. We appreciate your assistance as we implement this new process. \*Screen print orders will only be available for ordering twice a year (1st and 4th orders dates) including the uniform t-shirts.

\*4th order deadline November 8. Delivery December 11. 5th order deadline December 13. Delivery January 22. 6th order deadline January 24. Delivery February 27. Last order deadline for the year March 4. Delivery April 9.
