## Enrollment for 2024-2025 School Year—--Enroll Today!!!

You are an important part of our school community. We want to save your spot for next year! Enrollment for 2024-25 is open now, and current families must enroll by November 15 to receive priority. After November 15, enrollment will be open to other families in our parish followed by new families in the broader community.

## **Next Steps:**

- Scan the QR code to complete the <u>enrollment form</u>.
- After this form has been submitted, watch for an email within 2-3 weeks from Blackbaud Tuition Management to set up your account.
- Pay the \$100 per student enrollment fee when setting up your tuition account. (This replaces the registration fee typically due after the first of the year.)
- You will receive a confirmation email from Blackbaud when these steps are completed.



We recognize the revised enrollment process is taking place earlier than what you are accustomed to. We appreciate your assistance as we implement this new process. We invite all school families to attend Mass on Sunday, November 19 at 10:30 a.m. and represent St. Theresa Catholic School.


