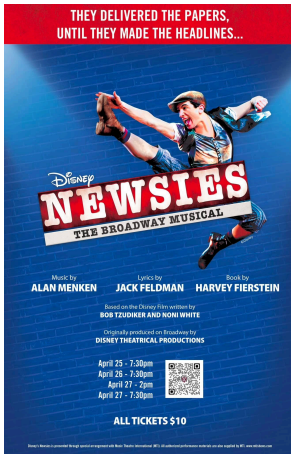

Attention 7th Graders

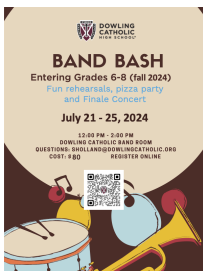

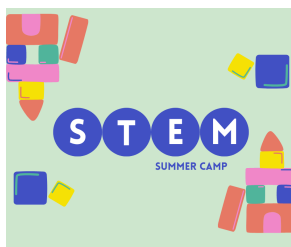

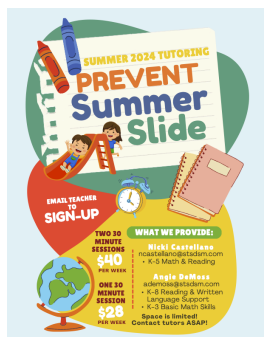
