Handbook Highlights - a little snippet each week from our Student/Family Handbook

Students Who Need to Leave During the Day No student is to leave the school grounds after arriving unless written permission or phone call from parents is shared with the teacher or office. It is critical that the office knows the location of all students for safety.. The process for students to leave early includes: • Parents of Pre-Kindergarten – 5th grade students must bring/meet their children in the office to sign them in and out when it is necessary for the students to be dismissed early. • Middle school students must sign in/out in the office after parent contact and can walk out to the car. Please notify the school office if there is a change in who is picking up your children. Students will not be allowed to go with a non-designated person unless the school office has been notified.
