Criteria to be a Sponsor

Sponsors for the sacrament of Confirmation must meet the conditions outlined in the Code of Canon Law (Can. 874 - 10) and the policy of the Diocese of Des Moines. Together they state that the person admitted to the role of sponsor must:

- 1. Be designated by the one to be confirmed
- 2. Not be one of the candidate's parents
- 3. Have the qualifications and the intent of performing this role
- 4. At least sixteen year of age
- 5. Be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the Sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist
- 6. Be an active, practicing Catholic
- 7. Be receiving the sacraments of Penance and Communion frequently
- 8. Be married in the Catholic Church, if married
- 9. Lead a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken

The pastor of the designated sponsor is normally responsible for determining that she/he understands the sponsor's role and is qualified to assume it.

Sponsor meets a minimum of two times privately with the candidate in each Preparation Year (Confirmation I and Confirmation II), minimum one hour each, for a total of four meetings.

Sponsors complete and submit the Sponsor Recommendation Form to the Pastor one month prior to the celebration of Confirmation.
